Applicants sought for Napa County Wildlife Conservation Commission

NAPA – The County Executive Officer announces one opening on the Wildlife Conservation Commission representing Youth (ages 15-25) for a two-year term, with the term commencing upon appointment.

Recruitment will remain opened until the vacancy is filled.

Commission Purpose: To advise the Board of Supervisors on policy matters related to the preservation and enhancement of wildlife and their habitats. The Commission annually submits a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors for allocation of State Department of Fish and Game fine monies. For the past decade, the Commission and Board have apportioned funds where they will best preserve/protect wildlife resources and educate the community in those matters.

The Commission meets quarterly and conducts special meetings on an on-call basis as needed, usually at the Napa County Administrative Building, 1195 3rd Street, Napa, CA, with some meetings held in the field at wildlife viewing locations across the County.
