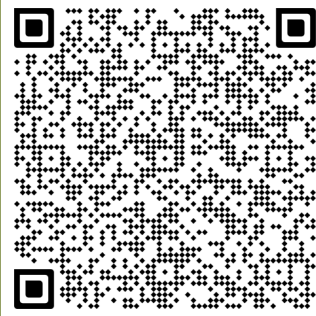

Learn about the importance of prescribed fire, how it works, and how the Napa Prescribed Burn Association empowers communities to implement good fire.

WHAT IS PRESCRIBED FIRE?

Prescribed fire is any fire applied to land in a strategic way to accomplish certain objectives. It is an essential and cost-effective stewardship tool.



We call it good fire!

Good fire can be used to support:

- 🔥 Healthy ecosystems
- 🔥 Safe communities
- 🔥 Tribal/cultural purposes
- 🔥 Wildfire resilience
- 🔥 Invasive species management



By returning beneficial fire to the landscape, we can reestablish a more historic fire regime, healthier ecosystems, and human connection to good fire.

The Napa Prescribed Burn Association (PBA) is a volunteer-based mutual-aid network that empowers communities to use responsible burning practices to restore ecosystem health and reduce the risk of catastrophic fire. We provide education, training, and resources to bring good fire to Napa County.
